## JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM WHAT WE CAN DO FOR YOU

The Junior Development Program is designed to assist Manitoba curling clubs and Manitoba schools in hosting curling clinics for juniors up to the age of twenty. The Foundation can assist in this regard by subsidizing a portion of the costs in hosting a clinic. The hosting organization applies for approval for funding prior to the clinic and receives reimbursement after the clinic.

## GUIDELINES FOR REIMBURSEMENT

- 1) The organization of the curling clinic must be done in conjunction with the Development Coordinator for Curling.
- 2) A written application must be submitted at least 2 weeks prior to the clinic.
- 3) In order to qualify for reimbursement, a club should be affiliated with the M.C.A. a Manitoba School or a recognized youth organization.
- 4) The clinic should be minimum of two hours or no more than eight hours or a maximum of 4 sessions.
- 5) Reimbursement will only be available for qualified Canadian Curling Association instructors.
- 6) Subsidy for instructors is based upon a ratio of 1 instructor to 8 students.
- 7) A detailed expense report must be submitted after the event to receive reimbursement.

## FUNDING GUIDELINES

- 1) Payment of instructors will be \$15.00 per hour of instruction per instructor (recommended 2 hours per session).
- 2) Payment of mileage per instructor as per MCA policy.
- 3) A maximum is available to each club or school per season. Exceptions will require prior approval.
- 4) Subsidy is not available for ice rental or printed materials and equipment or to fund leagues.
- 5) Reimbursement cheques will be made payable to host organization only.

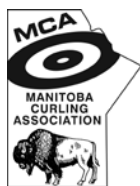

## MANITOBA CURLING FOUNDATION

### Scholarship Information

Each year the Manitoba Curling Foundation awards up to four \$1,000 scholarships to support juniors pursuing both academic and athletic excellence.

#### ELIGIBILITY

Any active junior curler entering or in post-secondary education may apply if affiliated as a junior during the year of application. Previous winners are ineligible. Minimum average for application is 70%

#### DEADLINE

Deadline for receipt of application is May 1st. Only original applications accepted. No faxes. Winners will be selected by June 1st.

#### SELECTION

Scholarships are awarded based upon the following:

- Curling achievements, development and contribution to the game of curling
- Academic achievement
- School and community involvement

## MANITOBA CURLING FOUNDATION

### Sport Award

The Manitoba Curling Foundation is looking for students involved in curling activities through a combination of roles: volunteer, athlete, coach, official, organizer. The Foundation will award \$250 to junior curlers from all Provincial Sport Regions to a maximum of fourteen awards per year.

#### ELIGIBILITY

A Grade 12 graduating student may receive a one-time award if s/he is enrolled in a post-secondary institution. The applicant must be a member of a curling club in the region of application. The application must be supported by a letter from the school principal and curling coach (or club executive member) and must include a current transcript. Minimum average for application is 70%.

#### DEADLINE

Deadline for receipt of applications is May 1st. Award will be forwarded upon receipt of proof of payment of fees to appropriate educational institution.

#### SELECTION

Applicant must:

- show a notable contribution to curling in their region or provincially
- must volunteer time and effort at curling related functions and activities
- other extra-curricular activities would be an asset
